Sample Scouting Report — Opposing Pitcher

This sample demonstrates the type of structured information coaches can collect before facing an opponent.

Category	Sample Notes
Hand / Style	Right-handed pitcher; works mostly from the stretch.
Primary pitches	Fastball, changeup, breaking ball.
Best pitch	Breaking ball for strikes early in counts.
Tendency	Fastball more frequently when behind in the count.
Hitter adjustment	Be ready to attack strikes early; don't expand on chase pitches.
Baserunning note	Check time to plate and pickoff frequency during warm-ups.
